RECOMMENDED PHOTOGRAPHY LOCATIONS IN THE BREVARD AREA

On the weekend of the Foto Fest, sunrise is at 7:10am and sunset is at 7:45pm. The first quarter moon occurs on September 15 and the full moon is on the 23rd.

Great photography locations abound in the Brevard area. Within easy driving distance are DuPont State Forest, Pisgah National Forest, and the Blue Ridge Parkway, each offering countless photo opportunities. Listed below are some of our favorite photo locations in the area. We encourage you to come early and stay late to take advantage of as many as you can.

- Moore Cove Falls

- Upper Falls and Second Falls at Graveyard Fields
- The West Fork Pigeon River corridor from the Blue Ridge Parkway at Beech Gap to Lake Logan
- The entire Blue Ridge Parkway corridor from Mount Pisgah to Balsam Gap (Pounding Mill Overlook is good for sunrise and Cowee Mountains Overlook is good for sunset.)
- The high-elevation grassy balds accessed in the Shining Rock Wilderness region (accessed by trail)
- Historic structures along the Campus Trail at the Cradle of Forestry
- Shining Creek Trail at the Big East Fork entrance to Shining Rock Wilderness
- The waterfalls of DuPont State Forest: Hooker Falls, Triple Falls, High Falls, and Bridal Veil Falls
- Views from John Rock and Looking Glass Rock (accessed by trail)
